#### 3. Matters arising

- Skateboard Park event : Jessica updated members on the planned skateboarding skills event planned for Spring 2011.
- Health Centre : Steve has spoken to Eddie McDonald at NHS Forth Valley who underlined the low priority of the Dunblane Health Centre in relation to funding for building improvements. Some internal reorganisation of spaces is feasible.
- Group Membership : Steve has spoken to Sally Fulton at the Cathedral who is seeking to find someone to attend meetings; the same is true of Bobby Anderson & Lynn Whitehead who are temporarily in charge at Scottish Churches House.

4. **Dunblane Centre** Lesley updated members on recent developments at the Centre. The volunteers enable a level of activity in the Centre which would otherwise be impossible.

5. **Braeport Centre** : The survey of the condition of the Centre has been received and is being assessed. Linda explained her role in developing a business plan for the Centre which will be part of the submission required to persuade the Council to transfer the Centre to DDT. The establishment of a Braeport Users Council is still on the cards (when time permits). There was also discussion about the future of the Victoria Hall.

6. **Survey of Community Facilities** : Barbara reported that the survey has received 12 responses to date - a further 7 are sought. Steve will get in touch with some of people who have not yet responded - Liz to provide some contact names. Preliminary results were discussed, particularly in relation to the Victoria Hall, the High School, the Sports Centre and the Scout Hall. Most evenings seem to be filled particularly by uniformed groups and sports activities. The relative costs of facilities were also discussed. The Council's charges are on their website. A full report back will be made at the next meeting. This piece of work will be followed by a survey of some of the groups that make use of community facilities in the Town.
