Improving the Environment in Dunblane

The inaugural meeting of a special working group being set up to improve the environment in Dunblane is due to take place next Thursday (3 June). The Environment Working Group is being set up by the new board of Dunblane Development Trust (DDT). It will be a sub committee of the DDT board and will have delegated decision-making powers.

Over the coming months, the Group will be responding to priorities identified in the 2009 Dunblane Community Plan for the 'Environment and Green Spaces'. These include promoting an anti litter strategy and developing open spaces in the town including the Laighhills and Holmehill.

'We are hoping to bring together the combined experience and expertise of the Dunblane in Bloom Group, the Mid Week Group, Sustainable Dunblane and the Dunblane Wildlife Group to work together to tackle a range of environmental issues in Dunblane' said DDT Board member, Morag Watson.

The inaugural meeting of the Environment Working Group will be held on Thursday 3 June 2010 at 7.30 in the Braeport Centre. The meeting is open to everyone in Dunblane whether or not they are DDT members.
