



DDT and the Community Council

What Do They Do?

There are many local groups in Dunblane working to improve the Town and the lives of its people.

Two such groups are the Community Council and the Development Trust. Not everyone knows what they do or what their respective responsibilities are..

Dunblane Community Council (DCC)

DCC is a statutory body; its members are elected to represent the views of the community to the local council and other public bodies and, where appropriate, to take action.

DCC can have up to 15 elected members. At present it has 12 plus one co-opted member. Its Chair is Terence O'Byrne.

DCC usually meets on the first Monday of the month at 7.30pm in the Burgh Chambers. Its meetings are open to the public. DDT was set up in 2003 because the Community Council cannot raise funds or own assets.

Dunblane Development Trust (DDT)

DDT is a charity and a company limited by guarantee. Its membership of 600 elects the board. DDT's role is to promote and take action in the community. At present issues that DDT is addressing include those relating to community facilities, the environment, tourism and the future development of the Town.

DDT runs the Braeport Centre. Income from the Trust's building in the High Street (Riverview) will be reinvested in community projects.

DDT's board has 12 elected members and could have up to 4 co-opted members; its Chair is Keir Bloomer. DDT's groups (see other column) are open to anyone who wishes to attend. Meetings are usually held in the Braeport Centre.

Working Together : DDT and DCC are working closely together, particularly on issues relating to the Local Development Plan and the Wind Farm Fund.
